


# #11127 4' Kids Picnic Table Assembly instructions

#### **TOOLS NEEDED:**

Drill with #2 Phillips Bit, '4" and 3/32" Drill Bits 2-7/16" Wrenches or Sockets File



#### TABLE TOP ASSEMBLY

(Refer to Upper Portion of Drawing 1)

On a large flat non-abrasive surface lay the four  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2} \times 48$ " table top rails with pilot holes for screws facing up. (Table top rails have pilot holes farthest from the ends of the rail.) Set the two 20" brackets over the pilot holes on each end of the table top rails, leaving a  $\frac{1}{8}$ " gap between rails. Fasten one bracket to rails with  $\frac{3}{4}$ " screws. Repeat for other end of table.

Apply glue to the inside edges of the  $\frac{7}{8}$  x  $\frac{11}{2}$  x  $\frac{22}{8}$ " end cap and **push** (do not slide from end) the end cap onto the end of each table top, taking care that the end cap is flush with the outer edges of table top.

#### **SEAT ASSEMBLY**

(Refer to Lower Portion of Drawing 1) (Make 2)

Lay out 2 pieces of seat rail with pilot holes facing up and an approximate gap of  $\frac{1}{8}$ " between them. (Seat rails have pilot holes closest to the ends of the rail.) Place an  $8\frac{3}{4}$ " bracket over pilot holes on one end of the seat rails and fasten bracket to rails with  $\frac{3}{4}$ " screws. Repeat on other end of seat. Apply glue to the inside edges of the  $\frac{7}{8}$  x  $1\frac{1}{2}$  x  $11\frac{1}{8}$ " end caps and **push** onto the ends of the seat rails.

#### TABLE LEG ASSEMBLY

(Refer to Drawing 2) (Make 2)

Lay two of the  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2} \times 27\frac{3}{4}$ " leg rails out at an angle, with pilot holes for attaching to table, nearest to each other at top. Lay one of the  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2} \times 48$ " cross rails across the legs; adjust legs so bolt holes line up. Using the  $\frac{1}{4} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " bolts, washers and nylock nuts, draw bolts up snug (do not over tighten). Note: The bolt heads will face the outside of the table. Using the  $\frac{7}{8} \times 1\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{8}$ " angle cut end caps for the bottom of the legs and the  $\frac{7}{8} \times 1\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ " end caps for the ends of the cross rail; apply glue and place mentioned above.

#### **COMPLETING TABLE ASSEMBLY**

(Refer to Drawing 3)

With tabletop upside down, insert one of the table leg assemblies into the bracket on the underside of the table top, with bolt heads facing the outside of the table. Using the  $\frac{1}{4}$  x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " bolts, washers and nylock nuts, draw bolts up snug with 7/16" wrenches. Repeat for opposite end of table.

#### DIAGONAL BRACE

Bolt both  $\frac{7}{8}$  x  $1\frac{1}{2}$  x  $21\frac{1}{4}$ " diagonal braces to the center of the cross rails of table leg assemblies using  $\frac{1}{4}$  x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " bolts, washers and nylock nuts. Bolt heads should face the outside of the picnic table. Fasten the opposite ends of the diagonal braces to the center of the table top as follows; overlap the ends of the two diagonal braces, drill two 3/32" holes through braces and into the tabletop. Fasten with  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " screws.


#### SEAT ATTACHMENT


Position seat rail assemblies over the horizontal cross rails of leg assemblies, line up the bolt holes of brackets to the holes in cross rail and fasten with  $\frac{1}{4} \times 2\frac{1}{4}$ " bolts, washers and nylock nuts.


### \*Upon completion of table be sure to file or sand any sharp edges on the end caps to prevent cuts and scrapes.\*

Any type of household cleaner without abrasives can be used for cleaning table.
